

2024 4-H Entertains Talent Show Rules and Regulations



Objectives:

- 1. To provide an opportunity for 4-H'ers to demonstrate their creativity through the performing arts.
- 2. To develop poise and self-confidence before a group of their peers.

Guidelines:

- 1. Any currently enrolled 4-H member(s) can participant in this event. Cloverbud-aged youth (ages 5-7) will not be judged competitively and will not be eligible for district competition.
- 2. Talent acts may consist of an individual or a group.
- 3. Talent acts should be family appropriate.
- 4. Acts may be dance, dramatics, variety, instrumental, or vocal.
- 5. Judges will select the top two acts (ages 9-18) to represent the county at the district level.
- 6. Each act should be a maximum of 5 minutes.
- 7. Participants should consider the following items when selecting and presenting a talent act.
 - a. Audience appeal
 - b. Projection
 - c. Appropriate dress or costume
 - d. Poise
 - e. Staging-position and/or movement on stage
 - f. Skills in areas of talent
- 8. Animal acts, use of fire, acts requiring excessive time to set up and/or special lighting are NOT allowed.
- 9. Microphones, in-house sound system, and piano are available. Participant is responsible for additional or specialized equipment.
- 10. There will be a MANDATORY practice on Thursday, May 23rd. Please schedule a practice time on that date between 9:00 am and 5:00 pm with the 4-H Office.
